

## 1000 Books Before Kindergarten How it works

For each child: Fill out a form and get a bag and a log.

Go and read!

For every book you read, color a star (or have your child color a star!). If you read the same book twice, color two stars. If you read it 18 times, color 18 stars. They can be library books or books you have at home or any books you run across. If you come to Story Hour, you can count the books Mr. B. reads to you. You can read together as a family and count it on all the logs you have. If you want to, you can log your children's favorite books, but that's not required.

Come back and show us your progress when you have finished at least one page. You'll get a sticker, a stamp on your hand, and a post-it (which you can color however you want) to add to our wall mural.

When you have finished 1,000 Books, you'll get a certificate of completion, a \$5 gift card to Lowry's bookstore, and a bookplate with your name on it in your favorite library book. Also, you'll get the pride of knowing you read 1,000 books! That's a LOT of books.

This is a self-guided program, so read at your family's pace and most of all, remember to have fun!
