

## 1000 Books Before Kindergarten How it Works

For each Child: Fill out a form and get a bag and a reading log.

## Now GO Read!

For every book you read, color a star (or have your child color a star!). If you read the same book twice, color two stars. If you read it 18 times, color 18 stars. They can be library books or books you have at home or any books you run across. If you come to Story Hour (at the library or online), you can count books Mr. B reads to you. You can read together as a family and count it on all the logs you have for your family.

If you want to, you can log your child's favorite books, but that's not required.

Come back and show us your progress when you have finished at least one page. (Or use the online form to report your progress.) You'll get a sticker, a stamp on your hand, and a post-it to color and add to the library wall.

When you have finished 1000 Books, you'll get a post-it to add to the wall, a certificate of completion, a \$5 gift card from Lowry's Bookstore, and a bookplate with your name on it in a favorite library book. Also, you'll get the pride of knowing that you read 1000 books! *That's a LOT of books.* 

This is a self-guided program, so read at your family's pace and most of all, *remember to have fun!*
