HERE'S WHAT TO EXPECT AT YOUR NEXT VISIT!

WHAT TO EXPECT FROM US:

- Protective plexiglass screens at service desks.
- Staff wearing masks at all times.
- A building that is sanitized daily, with high touch areas like keyboards, mice, and door handles cleaned throughout the day. Keyboard covers on shared computers.
- Toys, puzzles, newspapers, magazines, and other shareable items will not be available at this time.
- Hand sanitizer available on both floors.
- Marking to help you safely distance from others.
- Building occupancy will be limited to 25% of capacity at one time.
- All returned items will be quarantined for a minimum of 4 days.
- Patient and kind service from 6 feet away as we all adjust to our new situation.

WHAT WE EXPECT FROM YOU:

- You will wear a mask covering your mouth and nose at all times*. If you do not have a mask, one will be provided by the TRPL staff upon entry.
- You will not visit us if you are feeling ill or having any COVID-19 symptoms.
- You will honor the one hour max and not linger in the building any longer than necessary.
- You will maintain 6 feet of distance from other patrons.
- You will comply with staff directions and stay out of cordoned-off areas.
- You will not bring food or drink into the library.
- You will be patient and kind as we all adjust to our new situation.

*Children under the age of 2 will not be required to wear a mask. If you have a medical condition and cannot wear a mask, please call us and we will bring your items out to your car.
